



Global Alliance contribution to a 'masterplan' for HLPF 2019

ONE: Maximise the number of countries delivering quality reports on SDG 16 at HLPF 2019.

Political support for reporting countries:

- Bilateral Member State advocacy to encourage countries to 'sign up' to report in 2019.
- PR-level breakfast meetings to share experiences on inclusive, evidence-based reporting.

Technical support for 2018 reporting countries:

- Finalise SDG 16+ reporting template.
- Produce second version of report on how business data can enable national action on SDG 16, to demonstrate reciprocal value of public-private partnerships for data collection.
- Finalise repository of reporting resources: people who have addressed SDG 16 reporting challenges and are willing to advise others, and the products they developed or used (e.g. draft survey tools).
- Support three regional and three global meetings organised by DESA.
- Conduct 2018 and 2019 VNR review to track improvements in reporting on SDG 16+. Expand research to include review of: 1) whether and how human rights are included in VNRs and NHRIs are engaged in their preparation; 2) whether and how business data is utilised.
- Publicise work of Praia group, to ensure uptake of methodologies for measuring 16.6. and 16.7.

TWO: Support inclusive, evidence-based national reporting processes.

- Develop directory of resources to support measurement and implementation of SDG 16+.
- In three countries, support development of 'models' of effective reporting, and communicate globally.

THREE: Support provision and use of corporate data in national reporting processes.

- Advocate with businesses to share data to enable evidence-based action on SDG 16.
- Research to explore options for safe and effective transfer of business data for reporting purposes.
- Country-level work to link businesses and national authorities contributes to a shift in: 1) corporate willingness to share relevant data on SDG 16, with appropriate safeguards; and 2) national authorities' willingness to engage business as a partner in building an evidence-base for action on SDG 16.

FOUR: Support preparation of SDG 16 thematic review.

- 'Stories from the field' report of SDG 16 in action builds understanding how to implement SDG 16.
